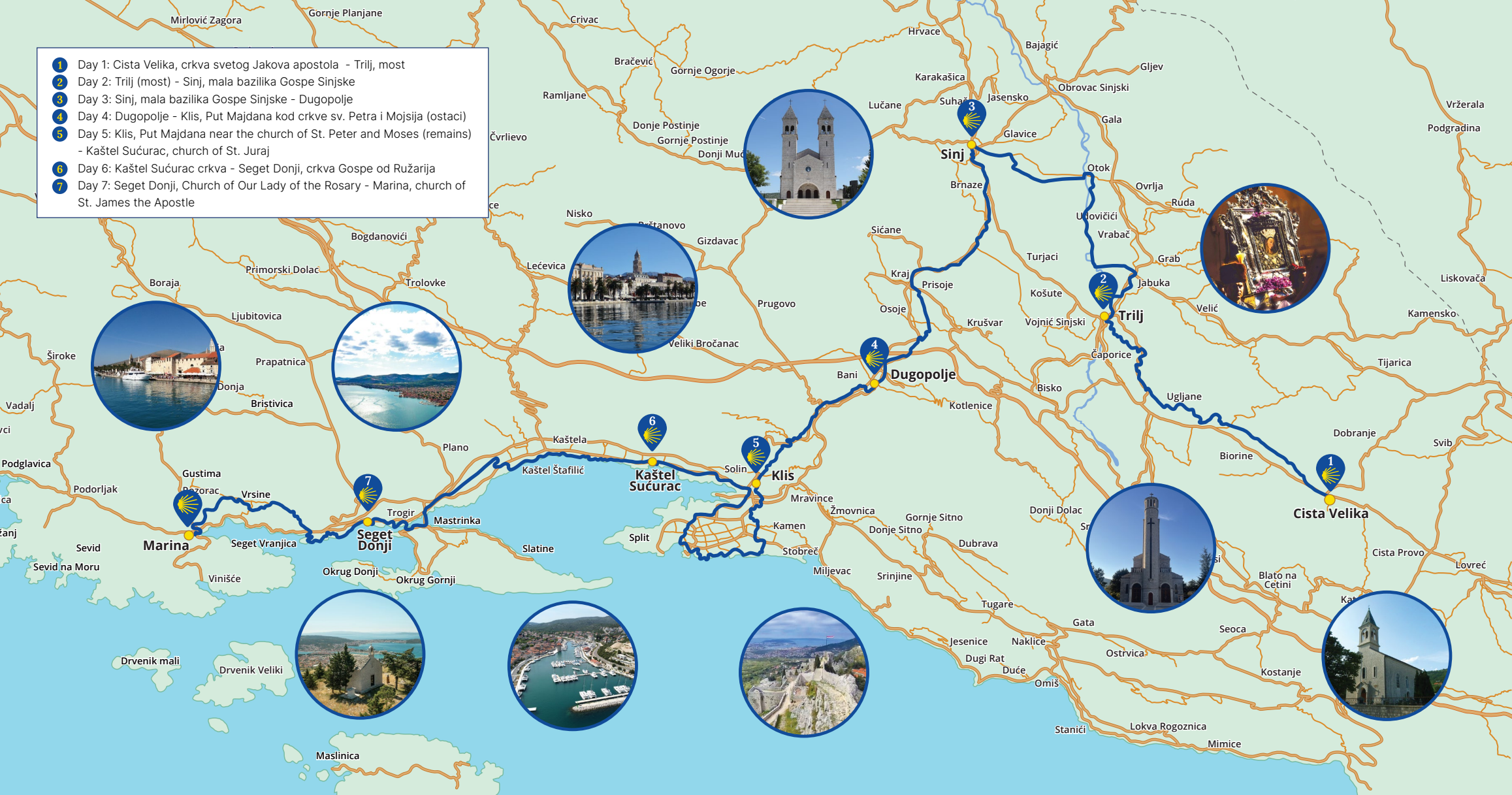

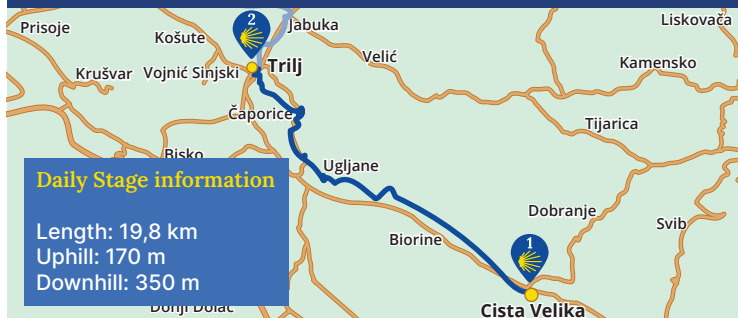

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Cista Velika - Biorine 5,8 km - Ugljane 12,8 km - Strmendolac 15,8 km - Trilj 19,8 km

Dan/Day 1: Cista Velika, crkva svetog Jakova apostola - Trilj, most

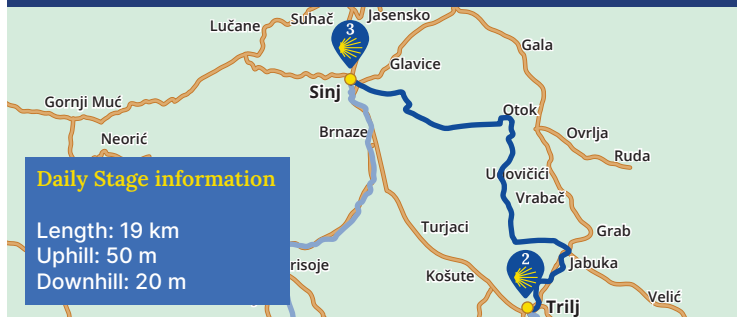


 Camino Srednja Dalmacija započinje u Cisti Velikoj, kod crkve sv. Jakova. Ruta prolazi kroz Biorine (lokalitet Pištet), uzvisine iznad mjesta Ugljana gdje su dostupni smještaj i okrijepa. Put se nastavlja prema Strmendolcu i završava u Trilju. Grad poznat po svojim mostovima ima sve potrebno hodočasniku od smještaja, restorana, kafića do ljekarne. Kod starog mosta šetnica uz Cetinu vozi do Gaza gdje također ima smještaj i restoran. Put vodi kroz prirodu, sela i tišinu Dalmatinske zagore, uz osjećaj duhovnog mira i povezanosti s prirodom.

 The Central Dalmatia Camino begins in Cista Velika, near the Church of St. James the Apostle. The trail leads through Biorine (Pištet site) and continues along the highlands above the village of Ugljane, where accommodation and refreshments can be found. From there, it passes through the peaceful hamlet of Strmendolec and ends in the town of Trilj. The city, famous for its bridges, has everything a pilgrim needs, from accommodation, restaurants, cafes to a pharmacy. At the old bridge, a promenade along the Cetina River leads to Gaza, where there is also accommodation and a restaurant. This stage offers a scenic walk through nature and rural villages, immersing pilgrims in the beauty and tranquility of the Dalmatian hinterland.

Trilj - Gaz 22,8 km - Viri^ć (Otok) 30,9 km - Sinj (center) 38,8 km

Dan/Day 2: Trilj (most) - Sinj, mala bazilika Gospe Sinjske



 Od centra Trilja hodočasnik kreće uz šetnicu uz rijeku Cetinu, preko triljskog polja, s nekoliko prijelaza ceste, prema Sinju. Putem s desne strane se nalazi mjesto Otok, poznato po tome što je dalo veliki broj duhovnih zvanja. Ulazeći u grad preko Piketa uz sportski aerodrom i hipodrom, može se zastati u nekom od kafića i uživati u pogledu. Cilj ovog dana je mala Bazilika Gospe Sinjske, važna duhovna točka ovog kraja. U blizini bazilike nalaze se brojni sadržaji: smještaji, restorani, tržnica, trgovine i ljekarna, pružajući sve potrebno za odmor i okrepu prije daljnjeg puta.

 Leaving Trilj, the path follows a riverside promenade along the Cetina River and crosses the fertile Trilj Field via several road junctions on the way to Sinj. On the right side of the road lies the town of Otok, renowned for producing a remarkable number of spiritual vocations. As you enter the town through Piket, near to the sports airfield and hippodrome, can take a break at one of the local cafés and enjoy the scenic view. The stage ends at the small Basilica of Our Lady of Sinj, a significant spiritual landmark in the region. Near the basilica, pilgrims will find ample amenities including accommodation, restaurants, a market, shops, and a pharmacy - ideal for rest and refreshment before continuing the journey.

Sinj - Brnaze 41,5 km - Dicmo (Klanac) 49,7 km - Kapela (Dugopolje) 55,1 km - Dugopolje (stadion) 57,4 km

Dan/Day 3: Sinj, mala bazilika Gospe Sinjske - Dugopolje

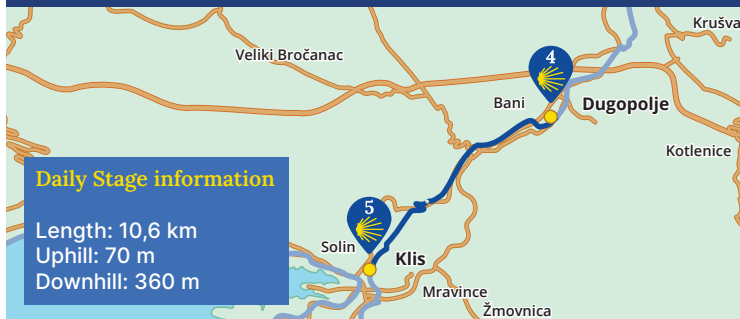


 Ruta iz Sinja vodi stazom Gospe Sinjske prema Dicmu, mjestu s crkvom sv. Jakova i sv. Ane. Napuštajući centar Sinja prolazimo Branazama, mjestu dječje alke. Nakon spusta iz Brnaza prelazimo glavnu cestu i nastavljamo put makadamom. Približavajući se Dicmu vidimo da je staza blizu ceste koja ima nekoliko kafića i fast.food. Ubrzo su tu i trgovina, pekara, kafić, ljekarna i privatni smještaji u Dicmu i okolici. Napuštajući stazu u centru Dicma ide se do crkve svetog Jakova koja je uz glavnu cestu, te se vraća na stazu. Put zatim nastavlja makadamom prema Križicama, a potom cestom do Dugopolja. U Dugopolju se nude brojni trgovački sadržaji, ljekarna i privatni smještaji za hodočasnike.

 The route from Sinj follows the pilgrimage path of Our Lady of Sinj toward Dicmo, where the Church of St. James and St. Anne is located. Upon leaving Sinj, the trail leads through Brnaze, a village known for the Children's Alka. After a descent, we cross the main road and continue along a gravel path. As we approach Dicmo, the trail runs near a road lined with cafés and fast food outlets. In Dicmo and the surrounding area, pilgrims will find a shop, bakery, café, pharmacy, and private accommodation. From the center of Dicmo, we visit the Church of St. James via the main road before returning to the trail. The route then continues along a gravel road to Križice and onward to Dugopolje, where shops, a pharmacy, and pilgrim accommodations are available.

Dugopolje - Klis-Grlo **61,8 km** - Klis (center) **63,6 km**

Dan/Day 4: Dugopolje - Klis, Put Majdana kod crkve sv. Petra i Mojsija (ostaci)



 Od Dugopolja do Klis Majdana put vodi dijelom cestom, dijelom makadamom, preko Klisa do Klis Majdana u neposrednoj blizini Gospina Otoka i crkvi u centru Solina. Spust s vrha Klisa u podnožje je malo strm u pojedinim djelovima ali s predivnim pogledom. Napuštajući Dugopolje, na području Klis Grlo nalaze se restorani s tradicionalnim specijalitetima ovog kraja, meso s raznja. Trgovina za opskrbu se nalazi u neposrednoj blizini Kliške tvrđave kao i kafić za predahnuti i napraviti pauzu prije spuštanja u Klis Majdan na samom ulazu u centar Solina. Pored privatnog smještaja ovdje postoji mogućnost i hotelskog smještaja, ljekarne, trgovina, restorana, objekta brze hrane i kafića.

 The route from Dugopolje to Klis Majdan follows a mix of paved roads and gravel paths, passing through Klis on its way toward Majdan, near Gospin Otok and the churches in the center of Solin. The descent from the Klis Fortress to the valley below is steep in sections, but it rewards pilgrims with breathtaking views. Shortly after leaving Dugopolje, in the Klis Grlo area, pilgrims can enjoy local cuisine at restaurants known for traditional spit-roasted meat. Near the Klis Fortress, there's a grocery store and a café - perfect for taking a rest before continuing to Klis Majdan at the entrance of Solin's town center. A variety of amenities are available here, including private and hotel accommodations, a pharmacy, shops, restaurants, fast food outlets, and cafés.

Klis - Pleštene 65,2 km - Klis-Majdan 67,6 km - Solin (center) 68,4 km - Split - Bilice II 69,6 km - Split 79,9 km - Split Predgrađe Kopilica 82,6 km - Solin-Meterize 85,7 km - Kaštel Sućurac (crkva) 91,7 km

Dan/Day 5: Klis, Put Majdana near the church of St. Peter and Moses (remains) - Kaštel Sućurac, church of St. Juraj



 Napuštajući Klis Majdan preko Solina, trasa prati gradske ulice do pješačkog mosta i Dioklecijanovog akvadukta, ulazeći u Split – najveći dalmatinski grad s obiljem trgovina, restorana, bolnica i kulturnih znamenitosti. Dan vodi kroz Split, uz obalu i gradsko Marijansko svetište Gospe od Pojišana. Slijedi silazak na Rivu, prolazak kroz Dioklecijanove podruma do katedrale sv. Duje, zatim do Grgura Ninskog i izlazak iz grada. Ruta nastavlja prema Kaštel Sućurac, prvom od sedam Kaštela i jedinom kroz koji put većinom ide nogostupom uz cestu.

 Departing from Klis Majdan, the path descends through Solin, following city streets to the pedestrian bridge and Diocletian's Aqueduct. The route then enters Split, the largest city in Dalmatia, rich with shops, restaurants, healthcare facilities, and cultural landmarks. Pilgrims pass through Split along the coast and by the Marian shrine of Our Lady of Pojišan. The journey continues to the Riva promenade, through the ancient Diocletian's Cellars, past the Cathedral of St. Domnius (St. Duje), and by the Gregory of Nin statue before exiting the city. From there, the path heads toward Kaštel Sućurac, the first of the seven Kaštela towns, where it mostly follows the roadside sidewalk. The day ends in Kaštel Sućurac at the Church of St. George.

Dan/Day 6: Kaštel Sućurac crkva - Seget Donji, crkva Gospe od Ružarija



 Napuštajući Kaštel Štafilić put vodi prema morskoj šetnici kroz idućih šest Kaštela – bogatih ugostiteljstvom, smještajem, ljekarnama ali i kulama (kaštelima) po kojima nose nazive sve do napuštanjaorskog puta prema splitskom aerodromu gdje put vodi makadamom uz pistu do Pantane, ornitološko-ichtiološki rezervata. Put u Trogir kratko vodi cestom gdje je potreban poseban oprez te nogostupom do mosta za Čiovo gdje se nalazi crkva svetog Jakova. Napuštajući crkvicu put vodi preko kamenog mosta lijevo prema Seget Donjem, ribarskim mjestom s trgovinom, pekarom i liječničkom ordinacijom, marinom, hotelima i privatnim smještajem.

 Departing from Kaštel Štafilić, the route follows the scenic seaside promenade through the remaining six Kaštela towns, each named after the medieval castle or fortress (kaštels). Along the way, pilgrims will find plenty of cafés, restaurants, accommodations, and pharmacies. Leaving the coastline near Split Airport, the path continues along a gravel road beside the runway and leads to the Pantan Nature Reserve, an important ornithological and ichthyological site. A short stretch along a main road- requiring extra caution- leads to a sidewalk that continues toward the bridge to Čiovo Island, where the Church of St. James stands. From there, the trail crosses a stone bridge and turns left toward Seget Donji, a small fishing village with shop, bakery, medical clinic, marina, hotels, and private accommodations.

Seget Donji crkva - Seget Vranjica crkva 116,6 km - Vrsine (Matijaši) 121,93 km - Marina 126,8 km

Dan/Day 7: Seget Donji, Church of Our Lady of the Rosary - Marina, church of St. James the Apostle



 Od Segeta Donjeg do Seget Vranjica vodi slikovita šetnica uz more i borovu šumu. Nakon Vranjice, cesta bez opskrbe vodi do Vrsina. Put dalje nastavlja makadamom kroz maslinike i kamena sela, zatim cestom do Marine. Na putu postoji opcija obilaska crkve Gospe od Snijega (6. st.) na Dridu. Camino Central Dalmatia završava kod crkve sv. Jakova u Marini naslanjajući se na Camino Šibenik prema Santiago de Composteli i grobu svetog Jakova.

 The day begins with a beautiful coastal walk from Seget Donji to Seget Vranjica, passing through pine forests and offering stunning sea views. After Vranjica, the route continues inland along a quiet road with no services, leading to the village of Vrsine. The trail then winds through olive groves and traditional stone villages via a gravel path, before reaching the road to Marina. Along the way, pilgrims have the option to detour to the ancient Church of Our Lady of Snows on Drid, dating back to the 6th century. The Central Dalmatia Camino concludes at the Church of St. James in Marina, where it connects with the Camino Šibenik. From here, the pilgrimage continues westward toward Santiago de Compostela and the final resting place of St. James.

- Camino stamps
- Compostela certificate



Credential is your official pilgrim passport. It proves you're walking the Camino, and opens doors (literally!). At the stops along the way, you collect Camino stamps in your pilgrim passport. Each stamp marks your progress and tells the story of your journey.



The Compostela is a unique certificate awarded to pilgrims who walked the Camino Zadar. It's a timeless souvenir, but more than that, it's a symbol of personal achievement and reflection.
